

# **CPYB** Assessment Information:

The CPYB Assessment will be completed in an online module format; one assessment for each of the five Principal Knowledge Categories/Topics. To be certified, you must pass all five module assessments, with an 80% or higher. Here's what you need to know:

# How do I get started?

Complete the CPYB Testing Assessment Registration Form.

## When will I have access to the assessments?

Within three business days of submitting your registration form, you will receive an email that has a unique URL, UserID, one-time passcode, deadline date and instructions.

#### How long do I have to complete these assessments?

You have 30 days from receipt of your credentials to complete the five assessments.

## How do I become certified?

You must pass each of the five module assessments with an 80% or higher, within your assigned 30-day window to achieve your certification.

## How many attempts do I have to pass a module assessment?

You will have *two attempts*, per module assessment, to score an 80% or higher. After the second failed attempt of a single module, you will be locked out of the full assessment and will need to resubmit the form to try again.

## What happens when I am locked out of the assessment because of two failed module attempts?

Your testing is considered a FAIL if you attempt a module twice and do not pass.

- You will need to re-register for another attempt at the full assessment.
- You will be given a new 30-day window.
- You must pass ALL five module assessments in the same 30-day window.
  - Any 'pass' for a module assessment will not roll over into the next 30-day window.

#### Can I skip questions on a module assessment?

A response to the first question is required before you can move on to the next question.

## If I need to take the module assessment again, will I see the same questions?

The module assessment questions are pulled from a question bank, so module assessments may be similar, but they are not identical.

#### Are the assessments timed?

There is no time limit, but each module assessment needs to be **completed in one session** – if you start and log off, your place in the module assessment will not have been saved and you will need to start again.

# What is the maximum number of attempts allowed for the full assessment before incurring an extra charge?
